Olivia leads ICL's educational initiatives and has helped train over 8,000 activists in political organizing. Olivia has two certificates from the Harvard Kennedy School's Executive Education Programs and over a decade of teaching experience. Olivia has also been one of Canada's most effective and well-known public figures; she served two terms as a School Trustee, four terms as a Toronto City Councillor, and eight years as a Member of Parliament.
